WELCOMING. GUIDING. SERVING.

You set the tone for the atmosphere.



YOUR HEART

Start here.

- ✓ Pray before you arrive.
- ✓ Come with a heart to serve, not to be seen.
- ✓ Stay aware of the atmosphere and the needs of others.
- ✓ Depend on the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ You are not in charge—the Holy Spirit is.



YOUR ROLE AS HOST



WELCOME WARMLY

Greet everyone with a smile and a kind word. Help them feel seen and comfortable.



ORIENT THE ROOM

Briefly explain the flow of the time and what people can expect.



CARE FOR PEOPLE

Be attentive to needs without being intrusive. Look for ways to serve.



PROTECT THE SPACE

Help maintain a distraction-free and reverent environment.



PRAY FAITHFULLY

Pray for the room, the people, and the move of God.



WHAT TO DO

- Arrive early and help set up.
- Know the schedule and flow.
- Keep the space clean and peaceful.
- Have tissues, water, and Bibles available.
- Help people find a seat and feel at home.
- Encourage participation, not performance.
- Keep time and transitions flowing.
- Communicate needs to the team leader.



WHAT TO AVOID

- Talking excessively or loudly.
- Correcting or confronting during the time.
- Using your phone during the room.
- Leading or directing the time.
- Allowing distractions in the room.
- Overexplaining or overcomplicating.
- Drawing attention to yourself.



REMEMBER

Small acts, eternal impact.

Your hospitality may be the reason someone encounters the presence of God today.



You open the door.



You create welcome.



You hold the space.



God does the rest.
